
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

President Trump issued an Executive Order on Providing for the Closing of Executive Departments and Agencies of the Federal Government on December 24, 2018. Pursuant to Section 1 of the Executive Order, all executive departments and agencies of the Federal Government shall be closed and their employees excused from duty on Monday, December 24, 2018, the day before Christmas Day. Following the lead of the executive branch, the Administrative Office will be closed, the Tenth Circuit will be closed, and this Court will be closed. To the extent that any time sensitive hearings are scheduled, the presiding judicial officer will determine how those will proceed.

The President's Executive Order declares that December 24, 2018, will be treated as a holiday for federal leave purposes.
